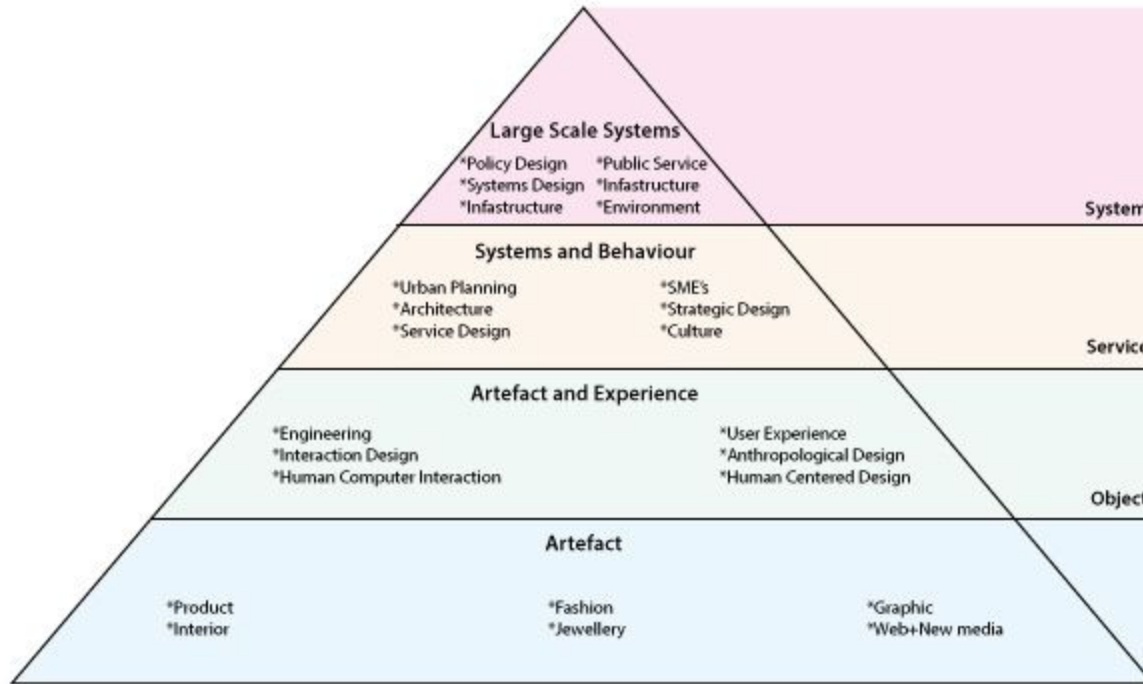

LOW

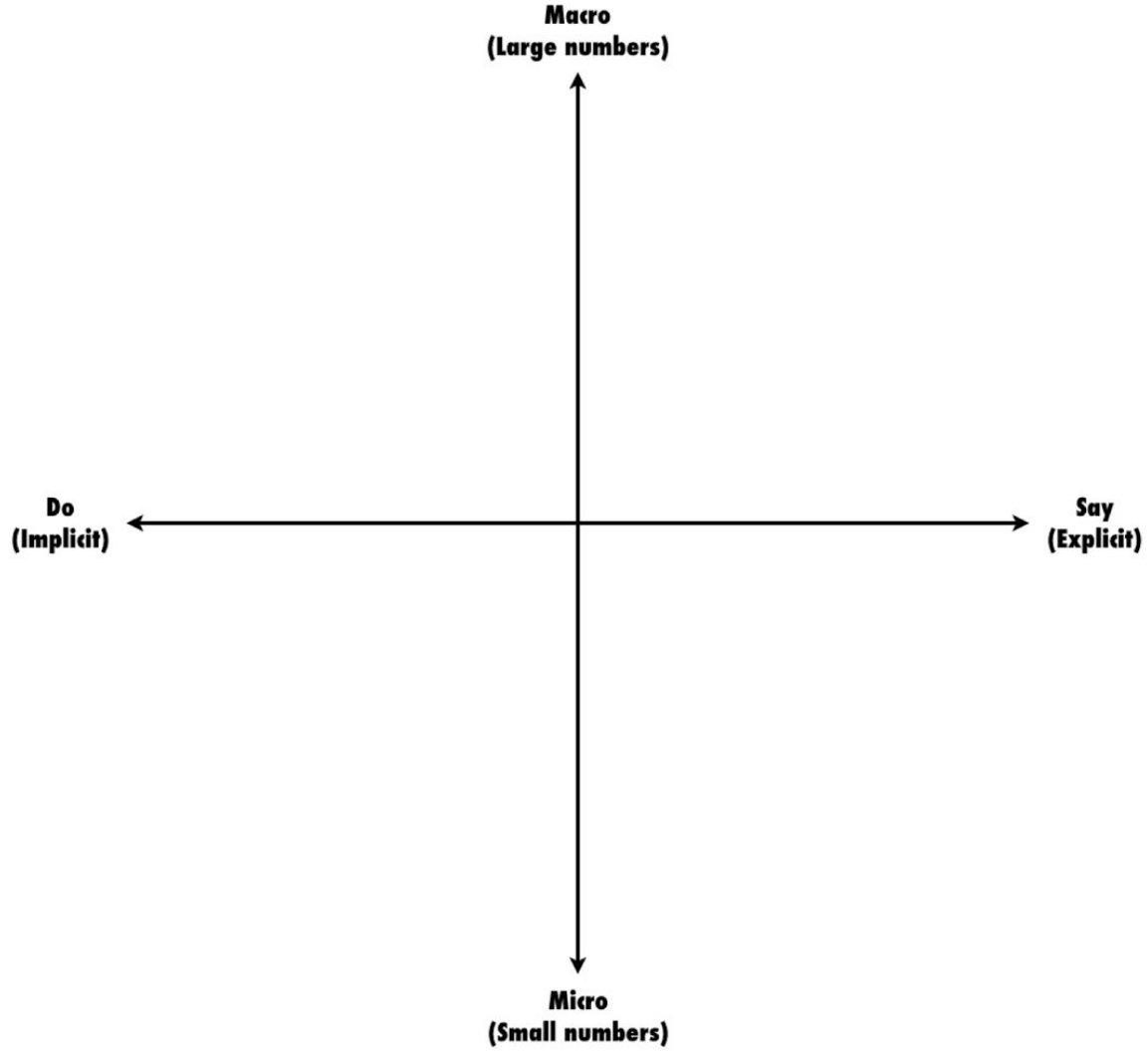


Questions/Comments
